KEVIN'S KORNER

Many Christians will use this time of the year to journey through the season of Lent. Lent is an opportunity to focus more intentionally and deeply on Jesus' suffering and death, leading up to the celebration of Easter. The pattern and significance of Jesus' death and resurrection are captured by Paul in Philippians 2:5-11. As you journey with fellow believers toward Easter, I encourage you to take the pieces of this Scripture passage (in italics) and use them to reflect on your own conformity to the way of Christ. Paul writes,

"In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:"

By God's grace, experienced through faith, you have been brought into fellowship with Christ and with Christ's people. This is what God has done for you. What are some ways you can cultivate oneness in our congregation? As you pray, ask God to form deepening connections between you and others in our church, especially newcomers.

"Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness."

In response to Christ's self-emptying love for us, what are some ways that you can promote cooperation, rather than competition, in our congregation? As you pray, ask God to show you how you can take the power entrusted to you and use it selflessly, on a daily basis, for the good and benefit of others.

"And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death – even death on a cross!"

In his suffering and crucifixion, Christ has identified himself with us in our humanity and secured the forgiveness of our sins. The cross is the central event in the story of our salvation. What are some things that can push the cross out of the center and onto the margins of your life? As you pray, confess these things and ask God to keep you mindful of the extent of Christ's sacrifice for your redemption.

"Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."

God's purpose is to bring all creation under the Lordship of the crucified and risen Jesus Christ. While we wait in hope for God to complete his work of salvation, faith enables us to experience the effects of God's victory even now. As you pray, ask God to help you take your entire life and make it an act of bowing to the sovereign love of Jesus.

Now close your reflections with Paul's words to the Philippians: "...continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose." (2:12b-13)

GRACE'S RECIPE BOX

Jewish Coffee Cake By Mildred Hack

1 pt. Sour cream

½ cup butter

2 cups sugar

4 eggs

3 cups flour

2 tsp vanilla

2 tsp soda

3 tsp baking powder

Cream butter, sugar, and eggs together. Add flour, soda, and baking powder. Add vanilla to cream and beat into mixture.

Filling:

½ cup sugar ½ cup nuts 2 tsp. Cinnamon

Layer of batter, layer of filling; rest of batter, rest of filling on top. Bake 375° for 40 min.

Fresh Apple Cake By Bea Bower

3 cups flour

2 cups sugar

1 tsp. Salt

1 tsp. Baking soda

3 cups fresh cup up apples

1 cup broken pecans

3 eggs, slightly beaten

1 cup Wesson oil

2 tsp. Vanilla

Sift the first four ingredients together. Mix dry ingredients with apples and pecans. Add remaining ingredients. Bake in ungreased tube pan at 350° for one hour.
